## REGISTRATION FEES

The three Registration Fees are one time fees paid at the time of registration in addition to Tuition.

**Parent Guild Fee: \$20**—Covers the cost and operations of the Academy Parent Guild

**Registration Fee: \$60**—Covers the cost of the registration software and the staff to support families during registration

**Preparatory and Beginning Ballet Performance Fee: \$30**—Helps to cover the costs associated with the end of the year performance including space rental, costume management, costume building, staff and production crew for run-throughs, rehearsals and performances. Tickets are not included in this fee.

**Youth Ballet, Primary, Intermediate and Advanced Performance Fee: \$60( first class) \$10 (additional classes)**—Helps to cover the costs associated with the end of the year performance including space rental, costume management, costume building, staff and production crew for run-throughs, rehearsals and performances. Tickets are not included in this fee.

## TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

### MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS

- Tuition for the 2018/2019 School Year paid in nine equal payments.
- **Payment schedule:** First installment is due at the time of registration. Credit card will be charged automatically on the first of each month for eight additional installments, beginning September 1, 2018 and ending April 1, 2019. A valid credit card must be on file to elect into the monthly installment option.

### SEMI-ANNUAL PAYMENT PLAN

- Tuition for the 2018/2019 School Year paid in two equal payments.
- **Discount of 5%** compared to paying in monthly installments.
- **Payment schedule:** First payment is due at the time of registration; second payment is due by December 15, 2018.

### ANNUAL PAYMENT PLAN

- Discount of 10% compared to paying in monthly installments.
- Tuition for the 2018/2019 School Year paid in full at the time of registration.

## PAYMENT POLICIES

- **An automatic credit/debit decline fee of \$10** will apply to any automatic payment that is declined on the auto debit date for any reason. It is the responsibility of the family to maintain valid credit card information. Card information can be updated in the Parent Portal under **FINANCES**.
- **A late fee of \$20** (*will be charged on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the payment due date*) for monthly and semi annual payments that are not made by the fifth day of the payment due date. If the payment is not made after the fifth day it will be combined with the next month's payment and charged on the first of the following month. A student will not be allowed to participate in classes on the Monday following a missed monthly tuition payment until this payment has been made.
- **Tuition is non-refundable. No portion of tuition will be refunded** in the event of absence, injury, relocation, decision to withdraw, or dismissal from the Academy. Future monthly payments may be cancelled upon written notice of withdrawal from the Academy.

## PREPARATORY DIVISION

**PREPARATORY DIVISION** classes are appropriate for students ages 3+. Classes meet once per week throughout the school year. Classes begin on August 27, 2018, and conclude with a Showcase on May 12, 2019. A complete Academy calendar is available online in the Parent Portal.

Parents should select a class based upon the student's age as of September 30, 2018. Charlotte Ballet Academy may change class placement based upon an individual student's maturity and physical strength.

### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

#### CREATIVE MOVEMENT

In a fun and encouraging environment, students explore musicality, rhythm, creativity and movement through space. This class introduces age-appropriate stretching, basic strengthening, balance, motor skill development and coordination.

#### PRE-BALLET

This class introduces classical ballet vocabulary, emphasizing musicality and individual creative expression in an innovative, fun and easy-to-learn manner.

## STUDENT OPEN DIVISION

**STUDENT OPEN DIVISION** classes are appropriate for students ages 6–14. Classes begin August 27, 2018. Students ages 9 and up also have the opportunity to audition to perform with Charlotte Ballet in *Nutcracker*. *Beginning Ballet* students classes end with a Showcase Performance on Sunday May 12, 2019. *Youth Ballet* classes end with a spring performance June 2, 2019.

### CLASS PLACEMENT

**BEGINNING BALLET** classes are recommended for students ages 6–9. A traditionally structured ballet class which includes French Ballet terminology that is for students with little or no ballet experience.

- Students who are new to ballet training will learn fundamental exercises and proper alignment, maintaining an emphasis on musicality, development of overall body strength, and the enjoyment of moving.
- Students who have completed the Academy's Pre-Ballet curriculum will continue to develop necessary foundational ballet skills to be prepared for Ballet 1.

**YOUTH BALLET** classes are recommended for students ages 10–14. A traditionally structured ballet class for students with a variety of dance backgrounds:

- Students who are new to ballet training
- Students who have had little, or intermittent periods of, ballet training
- Students who need stronger foundational ballet skills

Class emphasizes proper placement, familiarity with ballet vocabulary and French terminology, musicality, overall strengthening and the joy of movement.

- **Boys Dance** is open to boys ages 7-10 by audition only. Previous dance experience not required.
